

Feast of the Virgin of Altagracia - January 21"

The Dominican Republic has two Marian Invocations:

Our Lady of Mercy and the Virgin of Altagracia Protectress and Queen of the heart of the Dominicans. Her name "de la Altagracia" reminds us that through her we receive the greatest grace that is having Jesus Christ Our Lord. She, as mother, continues her mission of mediator, inseparably united with her Son. They affectionately call her "Tatica, la de Higüey" There are historical documents that prove that in the year 1502, on the Island of Santo Domingo, the Blessed Virgin was already worshiped under the invocation of Our Lady of Altagracia. The image is the symbol of Divine Motherhood" the painting is also an icon. There is not an element, a color or a relationship that does not have its meaning. There are indeed 62 different symbols in the image. The image had the special privilege of having been crowned twice; on August 15, 1922, by Pius XI and by Pope John Paul II on January 25, 1979.
