Dear Parishioners:

On November 3rd of last year, Bishop Brennan has written a letter addressed to everyone in the Diocese regarding the decline of Mass attendance together with the decline of priests in serving the parishes. The Bishop suggested to review the Mass schedule looking at the number of people at Mass in proportion to the capacity of the Church. In our parish we have six Masses every Sunday. We have four English Masses in Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary Church with one Spanish Mass, one Polish Mass at St. Stanislaus Church and the English Vigil Mass. Throughout the years, the 7:30am Mass has been decreasing in numbers. It is evident that parishioners are willing to come to Mass later than earlier in the morning. We can no longer afford to have the two Masses in the same language back-to-back with the decrease of attendance and the decrease of priests. We have another English Mass not too late in the morning but as early as 9:00am. As of now, we have four English Masses.

Therefore, after consultation with parishioners including pastoral council members and Clergy members, as of March 31st or Easter Sunday, the 7:30am Mass will be discontinued. The last 7:30am Mass will be celebrated on Palm Sunday. At this point, it is practical to have one first early morning English Mass and another late morning Mass with a good number of people in one Mass in proportion to the capacity of our Church. I am sorry for the inconvenience that this change could cause to some parishioners. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we adapt to new overall changes in our parishes.
