

# **Divine Mercy Novena**

# DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY FEAST April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024

Next Sunday is the feast of Divine Mercy Sunday, instituted by St. John Paul II, Pope. At the 11:30 am Mass we will celebrate the feast with teachings of Jesus to St. Faustina Kowalska about Divine Mercy, Eucharistic Adoration, Divine Mercy prayers including the Divine Mercy Chaplet, Benediction with the Most Blessed Sacrament and blessing with the relic of St. Faustina.

There is the possibility for all the faithful to gain a plenary indulgence in order to receive in great abundance the gift of the consolation of the Holy Spirit. In this way, the faithful can foster a growing love for God and for their neighbor, and after they have obtained God's pardon, they in turn might be persuaded to show a prompt pardon to their brothers and sisters. The plenary indulgence is granted (under the usual conditions of a sacramental confession, the sacrament of Mercy, Eucharistic communion and a prayer for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff) to the faithful who, on Divine Mercy Sunday, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, recite the Our Father and the Creed, and also adding a devout prayer (e.g. Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!).
