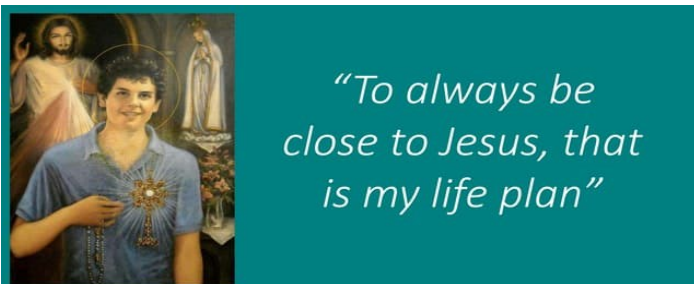

Saint Maria Goretti

Today, we have a very difficult story about a very beautiful soul. It tests the very limits of the human capacity for forgiveness.

Saint Maria Goretti proved forgiveness was possible in any situation. She proved forgiveness transforms the world.

Maria was born into a poor family in Italy. Her father had died when she was nine, and they could not afford their own home, so they shared a house with the Serinelli family.

On July 5, 1902, Alessandro Serenelli (a 20-year-old man who lived in the house) attacked Maria with the intention to rape her. She refused, and he threatened to kill her. According to testimony, she fought him and screamed, "No! It is a sin! God does not want it!" Then, Serenelli stabbed her.

Her mother found her on the floor and took her to the nearest hospital. Maria went into emergency surgery, but it became clear that she wasn't going to make it. She woke up during the surgery and one of the doctors said to her, "Maria, think of me in Paradise." Maria answered him, "I will gladly think of you."

From her hospital bed, she prayed that her mother would be all right. And then she did the unthinkable: She forgave Serenelli, her murderer. "For the love of Jesus, I forgive him, and I want him to be with me in Paradise."

And then, Saint Maria Goretti passed into Paradise.

Serenelli would have received life in prison, but since he was not yet 21, he was sentenced to 30 years. He was bitter and not sorry for his actions—until one day. It was 11 years into his jail term, and all of a sudden he had a vision of a garden. There was a young girl playing in it, dressed in white. He realized it was Maria. She brought him lilies, but he didn't want to take them. Maria urged him to take them, and finally he did. When he took each lily, it transformed into a white flame. Maria repeated her forgiveness for him, and then disappeared.

Serenelli's life changed that day. He repented, turned back to God, and became a model prisoner. After he finished his jail term, he went to the house of Maria's mother, and begged her forgiveness. She told him that if Maria had forgiven him, then she had to forgive him too. And so she did. Serenelli went on to become a Franciscan lay brother. He was present when Pope Pius XII canonized Maria as a saint.

Forgiveness transforms lives. Forgiveness transforms the world.

Your capacity for forgiveness is greater than you know.

She was beatified on April 27, 1947, and canonized on June 24, 1950, by Pope Pius XII. Her mother was present at her canonization — the only time a mother has ever been present for her child's canonization. She was the youngest officially recognized saint of the Catholic Church. She is a model of purity - a model all of us should try to imitate. St. Maria refused to break the Commandments and for that, she was rewarded with eternal life. Remember Our Lord's words, that we are to adhere to every Commandment of the Church, even the least important (Mt. 5:18-19). St. Maria is a model of all of us, especially the youth, to follow.

Today, Maria Goretti's home stands as a shrine, her hospital room as a chapel, and Alessandro Serenelli lived the latter years of his life as a religious brother. In a world saturated with blame and retaliation, this story offers a quiet but revolutionary truth: forgiveness does not erase the past — it redeems the future. What God can do with a wounded heart surrendered to mercy is nothing short of astonishing.

This story reminds us that forgiveness is not primarily about what others do to us, but about what we do with the wounds we carry. True forgiveness is not a single decision; it is a journey of faith — one that echoes Christ's own prayer from the Cross: "Father, forgive them" (Luke 23:34).
